Be advised that pursuant to Title 57 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"), and all other applicable laws and regulations, and under the general powers and duties of the Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner"), Respondents, American Bankers Life Assurance Company of Florida, American Bankers Insurance Company of Florida, American Security Insurance Company, and Union Security Life Insurance Company, (collectively, "Respondents"), are ordered to appear and show cause, if any, why appropriate disciplinary action should not be taken for the alleged violations of Nevada law set forth in the Complaint and Application for Order to Show Cause filed by the Division.

A hearing will be held before the Commissioner, or his appointed Hearing Officer, on the 14th day of March, 2012, at 1:30 p.m., at the offices of the Division, located at 1818 East College Parkway, Suite 103, Carson City, Nevada 89706.

1 Pursuant to NRS 233B.121(3), all parties may be represented by counsel at an
2 administrative hearing. Accordingly, Respondents may seek representation by a licensed
3 Nevada attorney, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC") 679B.313, and shall
4 notify the Division of such representation no later than five (5) business days prior to the date
5 of this hearing, pursuant to NAC 679B.311(2).

6 Written and oral evidence may be presented by the parties, and all parties will be given
7 an opportunity to be heard. The hearing will be conducted pursuant to Chapter 233B of the
8 NRS, Title 57 of the NRS, including NRS 679B.310, et seq., Chapter 679B of the NAC dealing
9 with hearings before the Division, and all other applicable laws and regulations.
