- 1) PY24 individual provider files, provided by Issuers, were combined. [Total of 146,872 ]
- 2) Duplicates among Issuers were identified using the National Provider Identifier (NPI) and removed. [19,177 remained after de-dupe process]
- 3) Data was filtered by taxonomy code to obtain the final count. NOTE: some providers have more than one taxonomy code.
