2025 Annual Administration and Enforcement Assessment

Pursuant to NRS 680C.110(6), the Nevada Division of Insurance will assess the Annual Administration and Enforcement fee to all company types having a Certificate of Authority as of January 1st of the assessment year. **Payment is due by July 1, 2025.**

On May 30, 2025, the Division will email your company's invoice. The invoice will be emailed to the address listed as the Annual Renewal Contact in your Company Profile on record.

IMPORTANT: It is imperative that your company contact information is up to date <u>no later</u> <u>than Friday, May 23, 2025</u>. Invoices will <u>not</u> be mailed and failure to pay your invoice on time will result in a late payment fine of \$25 per day.
