## 2025 Annual Fraud (Special Investigative Account) Assessment

Pursuant to NRS 679B.700, the Nevada Division of Insurance Division will assess the Annual Fraud fee to all company types having a Certificate of Authority as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the assessment year. **Payment is due by July 15, 2025.** 

On May 30, 2025, the Division will email your company's invoice. The invoice will be emailed to the address listed as the Fraud Assessment Contact in your Company Profile on record.

IMPORTANT: It is imperative that your company contact information is up to date <u>no later</u> than Friday, May 23, 2025. Invoices will <u>not</u> be mailed and failure to pay your invoice on time will result in an administrative fine in an amount equal to the assessment.
