Note: If a name does not appear in the search, this does not mean that the requested name will be approved. The fictitious name approval process is not automatic. Requests are considered on a case-by-case basis. Under Nevada law, the Commissioner may disapprove a name that is similar to a name already in use, misleads the public, or implies other services are offered that are not authorized by the license type, or if the licensee submits a request to use more than one fictitious name at a single business location.
